1. Check Your Voter Registration Status

Go to vote.pa.gov to see:

- if your voter registration is listed as "active"; if not, register to vote.
- your Polling Place; municipality, ward, and precinct
- your elected representatives in Federal and State government
- your political party

2. The First Time I Vote in a Polling Place

You will need approved PHOTO or NON-PHOTO ID. See lwvpgh.org/in-person

- **check-in** with an election official at a table which holds the **Poll Book**.
- the Poll Book contains a record of registered voters who are eligible to vote in the current election.





3. Registered to vote on time, but I didn't receive my Voter Registration ID card by Election Day

- keep checking your status at vote.pa.gov; See First-time Voters.
- Go to your Polling Place to vote! Even if you cannot verify that you are registered.
- See # 4

4. My name NOT found in the Poll Book ("Voter Record") when I check in.

- Ask the election officials to check the supplemental list and/or call the Election Office to verify your registration status.
- Your name is found; you will get a regular, paper ballot to vote.
- Your name is **not found**; ask for a **PROVISIONAL BALLOT**. Complete the form, sign your declaration, and get a receipt to search later at vote.pa.gov.
- Do not leave without voting--it is your RIGHT! After the election, your status will be verified by the County Election Office. If you ARE eligible-vote will be counted.
