www.vote.pa.gov: ONLINE is easy and quick--you just need a PA Driver's License OR PennDOT ID OR the last 4 digits of your SS# with uploaded signature. Not a PA resident? Go to **Turbovote.org** to register in your state. Selected entries here

www.vote.pa.gov: Download, print paper form or visit *Allegheny County Elections Division at 542 Forbes Ave, Ste 609, Pittsburgh, Pa 15219-2913, or call 412-350-4500. Use BLACK INK.



#1 Legal Name; Complete all checked boxes like, #2 "Eligibility" and "#3 "Reason"-New Registration; #4 BIRTH DATE required mm/dd/YYYY (18 by next election day); Phone# and Email recommended.

#5 Address; *County (like "Allegheny") is required; Municipality is not.
#7 ID: Only ONE form of ID is required- PA Driver's License OR PennDOT ID OR last 4 digits of Social Security Number with uploaded signature.

#5 Address; *County (like "Allegheny") is required; Municipality is not.
#7 ID: Only ONE form is required- either PA Driver's License OR PennDOT ID OR Last 4 digits of Social Security Number



#8 Political Party; choose Democratic or Republican if you want to vote in PA CLOSED Primary Elections.
#10 Changing Voter Registration info: go anytime to **www.vote.pa.gov** to update your registration, especially if you move.

#11 Declaration: MUST check; #13 Poll Workers are needed! See Elections Division **alleghenycounty.us**
